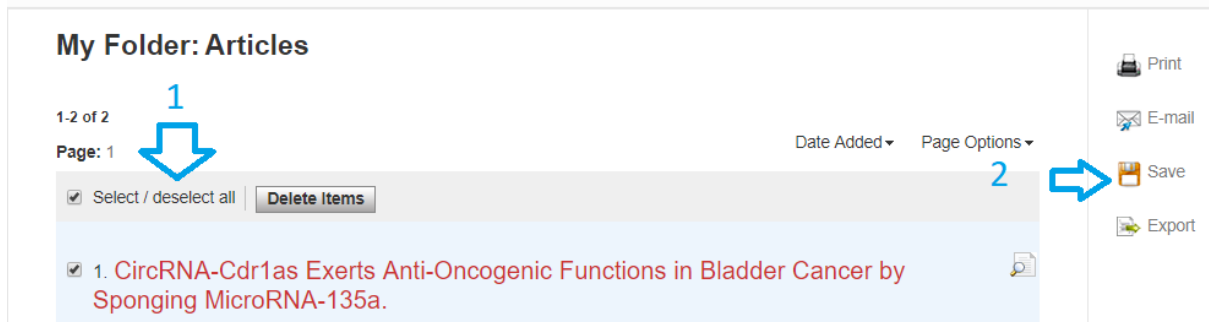


Instructions for saving articles and references from DISCOVER Folders

- 1) Log into your folder in DISCOVER. (If you have problems doing this, please contact library.technical@beds.ac.uk).
- 2) You will be taken to the My Folder: Articles screen. Click on the Select /deselect all tick-box and then click on the Save button.



- 3) You will be taken to the Save Manager screen. Select Standard Field Format = Detailed Citation and Abstract and then click on the Save button. Leave other options as they are.

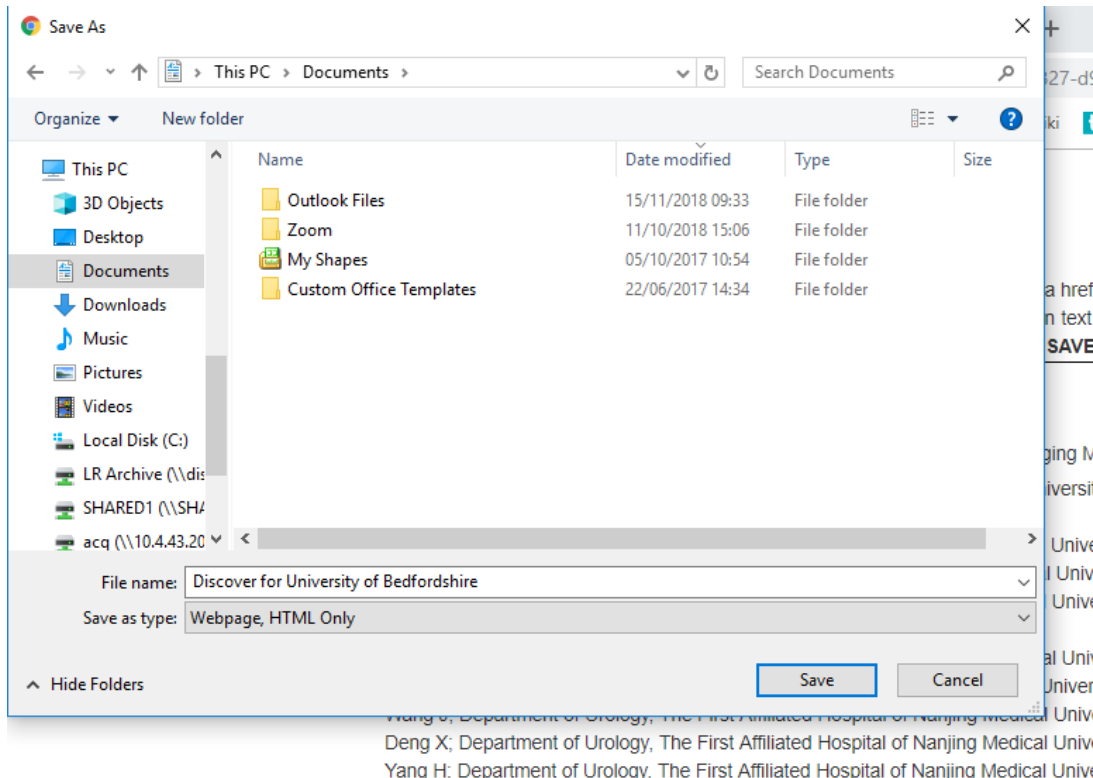
